Post-consumer Recycled Content (PCR)

OptiFlex® EcoFocus® BOPPs with PCR content (along with paper and/or polyester release liners that feature PCR content) is made from post-consumer recycled materials, minimizing reliance on virgin plastics.

Cavitated BOPP: Cavitated BOPP films contain microscopic “cavities” that reduce density while increasing opacity and stiffness. The result is a lighter-weight film that maintains performance while using less raw material.

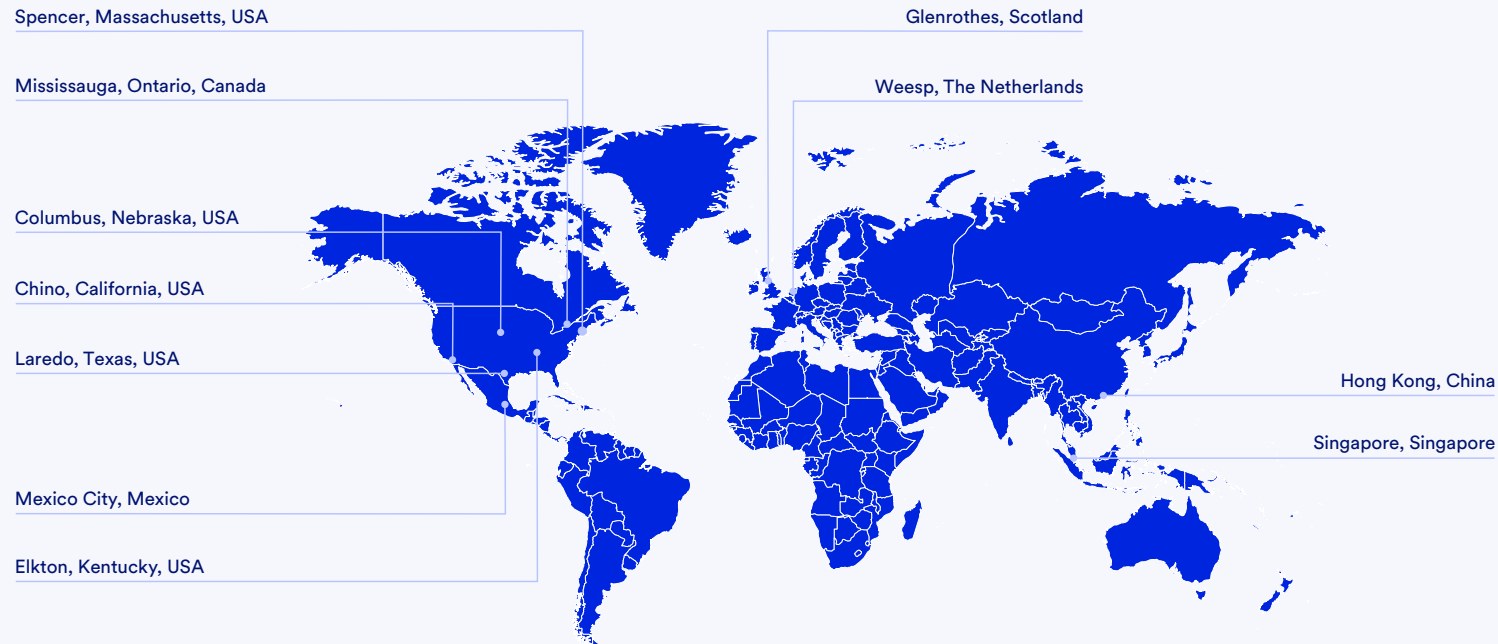
